Registered Nurse (UAS) competence at the beginning of the studies 1st academic year

Excellent 5

The student:

- is able to search for professional information related to clinical nursing from different scientific sources and validate the usage of this information in client-oriented clinical nursing
- is able to use and apply evidence-based knowledge in client-oriented clinical nursing
- is able to act responsibly and patient safely in client-oriented clinical nursing
- is able to justify his/her actions in client-oriented clinical nursing
- is able to work out professional tasks and problems related to client-oriented clinical nursing

- is unable to demonstrate sufficient ability to develop professionally and is unable to take part in developing client-oriented clinical nursing
